Construction

All fluoride products originate from the upstream production of hydrogen fluoride from fluorspar ore and sulphuric acid, that yields synthetic anhydrous calcium sulphate better known as gypsum, as co-product. Synthetic gypsum is of higher quality than natural gypsum and is preferably used in cement formulations for the building industry, plaster formulations for walls and ceilings and for dry wall plasterboard production.
